SPECIAL RULES FOR CLUB CALF & PROSPECT HEIFER SHOW AND SALE

1. In addition to these Special Rules, this department is subject to the General Rules and Regulations as stated in this Premium List, pages 9-13. All animals shown in these classes will be sale animals.
2. **OWNERSHIP** – All calves must have been owned by the exhibitor prior to September 1, 2011 and there shall be no change of ownership after that date. Club Calf sale groups will qualify as owners under this rule.
3. **ENTRY ELIGIBILITY**
 - a. Steers and heifers must be identified by a USDA-issued metal eartag or an ISO-compliant 15 digit eartag (including RFID)
 - b. Calves must be sired by beef breed sire.
 - c. All horned calves must be dehorned.
 - d. Club Calves may be shown only as a single calf.
 - e. Surgical (knife) castration is preferred. If other methods are used, testicles must be completely reabsorbed to be eligible to show.
 - f. **SINGLE CLUB CALVES**-Each exhibitor is limited to five (5) single entries. Steers only. Minimum weight 350lbs. Maximum weight 650lbs.
 - g. **Prospect Heifers** – Open to registered and commercial heifers born January 1 through May 31, 2011. Heifers will be shown individually in up to three classes divided by weight. Entry form must show complete age of animal(s). Entries are limited to 5 animals for each exhibitor and animals shown in these classes may not show in any other class in the Exposition. Prospect Heifers must be at least 350 pounds and not more than 650 pounds.
4. **IMPORTANT** – All animals, club calves and heifers, must be halter broken to tie and lead. The sale will be held in the Small Arena.
5. Purebred feeder calves of any breed may show as a separate breed, provided they meet breed specifications for registration or recording in their breed association.
6. **HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS** – Entries must comply with all Health Rules, as stated for Breeding cattle, pages 44-47 except steers need not comply with Brucellosis requirements. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be in the exhibitor/owner's name. **ONLY** one (1) owner's animal per Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. A photocopy of the CVI for every animal shown must be turned in during check-in on Thursday. For example, if an exhibitor is showing two animals, he must submit two copies, one for each animal.
7. **ENTRY FEE** – See Beef Fee Table Rule 11, page 10. Note: Pennsylvania Livestock Association (PLA) members receive a discount on entry fees. The annual membership can be renewed via sending payment along with your entry form, online registration, and using the membership form on page 165 of this book and submitting it along with the appropriate fee to Lois Rankin. (Show entry fee includes bedding per calf)

8. **SUBSTITUTION-** Substitutions within breed will be permitted and, if made, must be filed with the department superintendent not later than the time animals are checked in the EXPOSITION by the breed clerk.
9. **Premiums - All premiums are subject to change by show management dependent upon funding support.**
10. **ARRIVAL TIME-** Calves must be in pens by 12:00 Noon THURSDAY, October 6.
11. **HOUSING –** All club calves will be housed together in one location determined by Show Management.
12. **TRAILERS –** New Rule: All trailers may be parked on-site as space permits. Off-site trailer parking is encouraged. Please see the Map on page 171 for directions.
13. **WEIGHING –** New Rule: Calves must be weighed on THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, starting at 5:00 P.M.
14. **MUZZLES-** No animal may be muzzled at any time during the EXPOSITION.
15. A committee, representing show management, will observe the handling of all animals, both in and out of show ring and will have the authority to disqualify any exhibitor for unethical practices.
16. **SALE-** All club calves and heifers will be sold at auction by the head. A commission of 6% will be charged.
17. All calves offered at auction must be sold. Any exhibitor “buying back” their calves will not be permitted to participate in future expositions. However, the consignor has the privilege of announcing “No Sale” at the conclusion of bidding. A \$100 commission will be assessed regardless of the bid offered.
18. The sale is a contract between buyer and seller. Animals purchased become the immediate property of the successful bidder and subject to delivery at the close of the sale upon payment of the purchase price. Care and feeding of purchased animals is the responsibility of the buyer. The buyer is responsible for securing proper import permits and meeting import regulations as required by the state of import.
19. Sale proceeds will be mailed to the consignor in 10 days or less following the Sale.
