## **Keystone Livestock International Exposition**

The 55<sup>th</sup> Keystone International Livestock Exposition (KILE) will be held from Oct. 1-9. We will be hosting some of the nation's best cattle, sheep, swine and horses at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex and Expo Center in Harrisburg.

The cattle department will host one of six national Hereford shows, the National American British White Park show, the Limousin breed's "Medal of Excellence" Level II show, and the official Pennsylvania State Shorthorn Show that is designated as the Atlantic Major Pace Show. For the 10<sup>th</sup> year, Red Angus, Highland and Texas Longhorn cattle will show, along with MaineTainers for the seventh year. For the sixth year, Charolais will show as a regional points show, and Angus, Simmental and Maine-Anjou will also be exhibited. Sales are set for Angus and the ever-popular Club Calf Sale and the Prospect Heifer Sale. New this year is the Keystone Heifer Showcase Sale.

The sixth annual Youth Beef Benefit Auction will again offer its proceeds to the Beef Scholarship program, providing two beef youth with \$1,000 and \$500 in scholarships.

Back in 2011, the Keystone Classic Show and Sale will feature all eight swine breeds. A barrow show is scheduled along with the Live Hog Evaluation Contest, and the National Junior Swine Association will host its 11<sup>th</sup> Eastern Regional Show.

The sheep department will host the Regional Hampshire Show, in addition to six breed ewe sales and the seventh year of Natural Colored fines and mediums. The all-time favorite Leadline will be held Saturday of show week.

Supreme champion males and females will be named in beef, swine and sheep.

KILE will once again host the qualifying show for the North American Six Horse Hitch that pits 25 of the nation's top-rated six horse hitches in competition for the 2012 national championship. The crowd-pleasing All-Breeds Classic Series Six Horse Hitch Show is set for Saturday night's events.

The two-day Haflinger Show returns for the sixth year, along with the one-day, two-judge Paso Fino Show that is double-pointed. We will also host the Regional Shire Show, Clydesdale, Percheron and Belgian shows.

Livestock youth will compete in the Collegiate and Junior Livestock Judging Contest and the Keystone Stockman's Contest, in addition to the High School Rodeo.

Thursday, Oct. 6, is the Farm-City Day event, where nearly 1,000 local students will visit KILE to learn about agriculture.

The Keystone Classic Barbeque, a fully-sanctioned Kansas City Barbeque Society contest, is back. As a state championship, the winner receives an automatic invitation to compete in the two largest barbeque contests in the country.

The 2011 KILE promises to be filled with high-caliber shows, contests and activities. We look forward to welcoming exhibitors, sponsors and friends back to Harrisburg to celebrate more than 55 years of livestock excellence.
