GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- (a). **Certificate of Veterinary Inspection:** All equine animals to be exhibited must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed, dated and issued by an accredited veterinarian within the 30 days prior to the date of arrival at the show. The name of the laboratory conducting the EIA test, and the date of the test and negative test result must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. For out-of-state animals, the accredited veterinarian must send a copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection to the State Veterinarian of the state of origin for approval.
 - (b). **Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) Test Requirements:** All equine animals must have tested negative for EIA by an official test within the 12 months prior to the date of arrival at the show. A copy of the official test results must accompany each animal to its final destination. Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from EIA testing requirements. If the foal is less than 6 months of age and is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination. The negative report must accompany the equine and must include an accurate description including age, color, sex and any other reliable identification such as tattoos, distinctive marks, etc. Solid color animals must be identified by some method of unique identification such as lip tattoo, brand, or at least two distinctive markings such as whirls. The name of the laboratory conducting the EIA test, and the date of the test and result must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
IMPORTANT- A photocopy of the test report must be submitted with the KILE entry form.
 - (c). **VETERINARIAN-CLIENT-PATIENT-RELATIONSHIP:** By entry into the exposition you are confirming that you have established a Veterinarian-Client-Patient-Relationship for the animals you are entering and/or exhibiting. A Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship is a relationship in which the veterinarian has assumed the responsibility for making veterinary medical judgments regarding the health of the animal and the need for veterinary medical treatment and the owner or caretaker of the animal has agreed to follow the instructions of the veterinarian in relation to zoonotic diseases.
 - (d). **Vaccination Recommendations:** The Department recommends that exhibitors consult with their veterinarians about the proper vaccination regimen for their animals.
2. **HEALTH OF ANIMALS:** No animal showing signs of infectious, contagious, or external parasitic disease will be allowed into the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center. However, exhibitors who observe an animal that may present a health hazard to other animals are asked to report the stall location to the show committee. The official show veterinarian in consultation with Show Management shall be responsible for determining the health status of all animals. Animals showing evidence of infectious, contagious, or external parasitic diseases shall be removed by their owner from the show grounds at the direction of Show Management.
 3. **HEALTH CERTIFICATION DOCUMENTS:** No animal will be allowed into the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center unless they are accompanied by the required health certification documents. Additionally, the Certificate

of Veterinary Inspection must be available for inspection upon request at all times while the animal is on the premises.

VETERINARIAN'S CHECKLIST

- ❑ **ALL HORSES** must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed, dated and issued by an accredited veterinarian within thirty (30) days prior to the date of arrival at the show.
- ❑ **EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA TESTING REQUIREMENTS**
All equine animals must have tested negative for EIA by an official test within the 12 months prior to the date of arrival at the show. A copy of the official test results must accompany each animal to its final destination. Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from EIA testing requirements. If the foal is less than six months of age and is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination

IMPORTANT- A photocopy of the test report must be submitted with the KILE entry form.

4. **ENTRIES**-All entries shall be made on entry forms provided by the exposition. *A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM IS NEEDED FOR EACH OWNER.* All incorrectly filled out entry forms will be returned. Entries may be submitted online at www.keystoneinternational.state.pa.us.
5. **ENTRY DEADLINE SEPTEMBER 9**-Entries must be postmarked or computer time stamped (online registration) on or before September 9 (postage meter date not accepted). Entries postmarked or computer time stamped (online registration) after September 9 are considered post entries and must pay post entry fees as stated in rule 6 below.
6. **POST ENTRIES**-Post entries will be accepted if made at least two classes prior to the call of the class to be entered and will be accepted at the After 9/09/11 fee. **Entries made after September 9 with a horse entered prior to September 9 will follow the "By September 9" fee schedule.**

SUBSTITUTIONS-Will be permitted within breed in HALTER CLASSES ONLY. Substitute entries must have been owned by exhibitor prior to September 27.
7. **CHAMPION CLASSES**-Horses must have been entered, shown and judged in qualifying classes as specified in order to be eligible in these classes.
8. **ENTRY FEES**-The fee schedule is listed under the specifications of each breed show, and on pages 11-12, U.S. FUNDS ONLY. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS THE FULL PAYMENT OF FEES ACCOMPANIES THE ENTRIES INCLUDING ONLINE REGISTRATIONS. AFTER SEPTEMBER 9, ENTRY FEES ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE FROM HORSE TO HORSE OR FROM CLASS TO CLASS except in qualified SUBSTITUTIONS per Rule 6, page 25. A 10% SURCHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ALL CHECKS RETURNED BECAUSE OF INSUFFICIENT FUNDS OR CLOSED ACCOUNTS.**
9. **REFUNDS-FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE PAST THE SEPTEMBER 9 ENTRY DEADLINE**
10. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days of the close of the Exposition.

11. **Premiums** - Show management reserves the right to adjust premiums based upon funding support.
12. **IMPORTANT!** - Any exhibitor or other person, directing physical abuse in any form towards a horse, will be immediately dismissed from the show and will forfeit all fees & premiums.
13. **BOX STALL ASSIGNMENT**-The horses of two or more exhibitors will be stalled together only if the exhibitors send all their entries, with a written request, in one envelope. Each exhibitors entry form must specify who they want to be stalled with.
14. **CANCELLATION OF CLASSES**-The management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes insufficiently filled. In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee will be forfeited.
15. **RING NUMBERS**-Upon arrival at the Show Building, each exhibitor or his representative shall report to the Horse Show Office during Horse Show Office hours to **VERIFY ENTRIES WITH REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES, ANIMAL HEALTH BLUE CARD and ANY SPECIFIC BREED ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENT** to receive stable assignment and ring numbers. **Exhibitors using ring numbers not assigned by show management will be disqualified.**
16. **BREED SPECIFICATIONS**-Items pertaining to specific breeds are listed under the breed divisions and are considered part of the Rules and Regulations.
17. **PROTEST**-Protest may be made to the show committee by an exhibitor for any violation of rules. All protests must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the show superintendent and received by the Show Manager, Show Superintendent or by a member of the Show Committee within 48 hours of the alleged violation. A \$50 check deposit must accompany any protest; deposit will be returned in the event the protest is sustained.
18. **STALLS**-Approximately 200 temporary box stalls with doors will be available for each breed. These will be assigned to the first entries received. Exhibitors may not purchase more box stalls than the number of horses entered. A limited number of tack stalls will be available at \$40.00 each. **DO NOT REMOVE PANELS FROM ANY STALL!! EXHIBITORS WILL BE CHARGED \$50 PER PANEL FOR ALL PANELS REMOVED WITHOUT PERMISSION. CONTACT THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE IF YOU NEED PANELS REMOVED.**
19. **NEW RULE: ALL HORSE TRAILER PARKING, WILL BE ON-SITE BEGINNING FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 30, 12 NOON. OFF-SITE PARKING IS ENCOURAGED. (SEE MAP, PAGE 171). UNLOADING AND LOADING IS PERMITTED ON-SITE.**
20. Bedding must be provided by the exhibitor. Straw and shavings are permitted. A reputable dealer will be present in the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center to supply grain, hay, straw and shavings at local prices during Feed Room Hours (See Page 22).
21. **DOGS**-No dogs, except service dogs, leashed or unleashed, are permitted in the Farm Show Building during the Keystone International Livestock Exposition.
22. **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE SCHEDULE**-The continuing growth of these horse shows, plus limited housing space, necessitates that all exhibitors strictly adhere to the arrival and departure schedule as shown on page 22.

23. Lunging is permitted in the outdoor exercise area, and during specified indoor arena exercise times (see page 22). Lunging is not permitted at any time in any other exercise areas.
24. The Equine Arena is 150' x 300' and Large Arena is 120' x 240'. The Equine Arena and Large Arena footing is a mixture of clay, sawdust and tanbark. The footing in the exercise arena is very fine stone with dust.

REGISTRATION-All horses, except weanling, must have been issued a registration certificate by their respective breed association in order to compete. A weanling may be exhibited without a registration certificate, but must be shown as “unnamed” and must be eligible for registration. Geldings, except Shire, may not show in group classes.

ENTRIES- Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class in the halter divisions and one entry per class in cart classes.

DRESS CODE- NO blue jeans.

STALL AVAILABILITY- Haflingers arrive Friday, September 30 at 12 Noon and must vacate Monday, October 3 at 8:00 a.m. Stalls will be available for Draft Horses by 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, October 4. Stalls must be VACATED by 7:00 a.m., Sunday, October 9. **DO NOT REMOVE PANELS FROM ANY STALL!! EXHIBITORS WILL BE CHARGED \$50 PER PANEL FOR ALL PANELS REMOVED WITHOUT PERMISSION. CONTACT THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE IF YOU NEED PANELS REMOVED.**

American SHIRE Horse Association SHOW Eligibility RULES

- A. Shire stallions, mares, and geldings registered with the American Shire Horse Association (ASHA), the Canadian Shire Horse Association (CSHA) or the Shire Horse Society (SHS) are eligible to show in registered classes. "Notified Colts" that are parentage verified and recorded in the name of the exhibitor are eligible to show
- B. Foals must be registered.
- C. Horses must be entered by the owner(s) listed on the horse's registration paper. Show entry forms usually list this as 'exhibitor' or 'entrant'. Persons acting as agent or handler for the horse being shown may not be listed as the exhibitor. The owner does not have to be the person showing the horse. Leased horses may be entered by the leaser as recorded by the respective associations.
- D. Mares registered as 3/4 and 7/8 Shire may be shown with full registered mares. Geldings registered as 3/4, 7/8 or 15/16 Shire may be shown with full registered geldings.
- E. Geldings must be registered with a recognized Shire registry to be eligible for championships, best of breed or supreme champion titles, as well as Premier Points. Registered geldings must **also** be parentage verified in order to qualify for Premier Points.
- F. Geldings that are not registered must be of Shire type to show in a grade gelding class.
- G. When a horse registered with SHS or CHSA (but not with ASHA) is entered, a copy of the registration paper must be sent to the ASHA Secretary in order to allow verification of eligibility.
