- Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th in all classes. Rosettes will be awarded for champions and reserve champions.

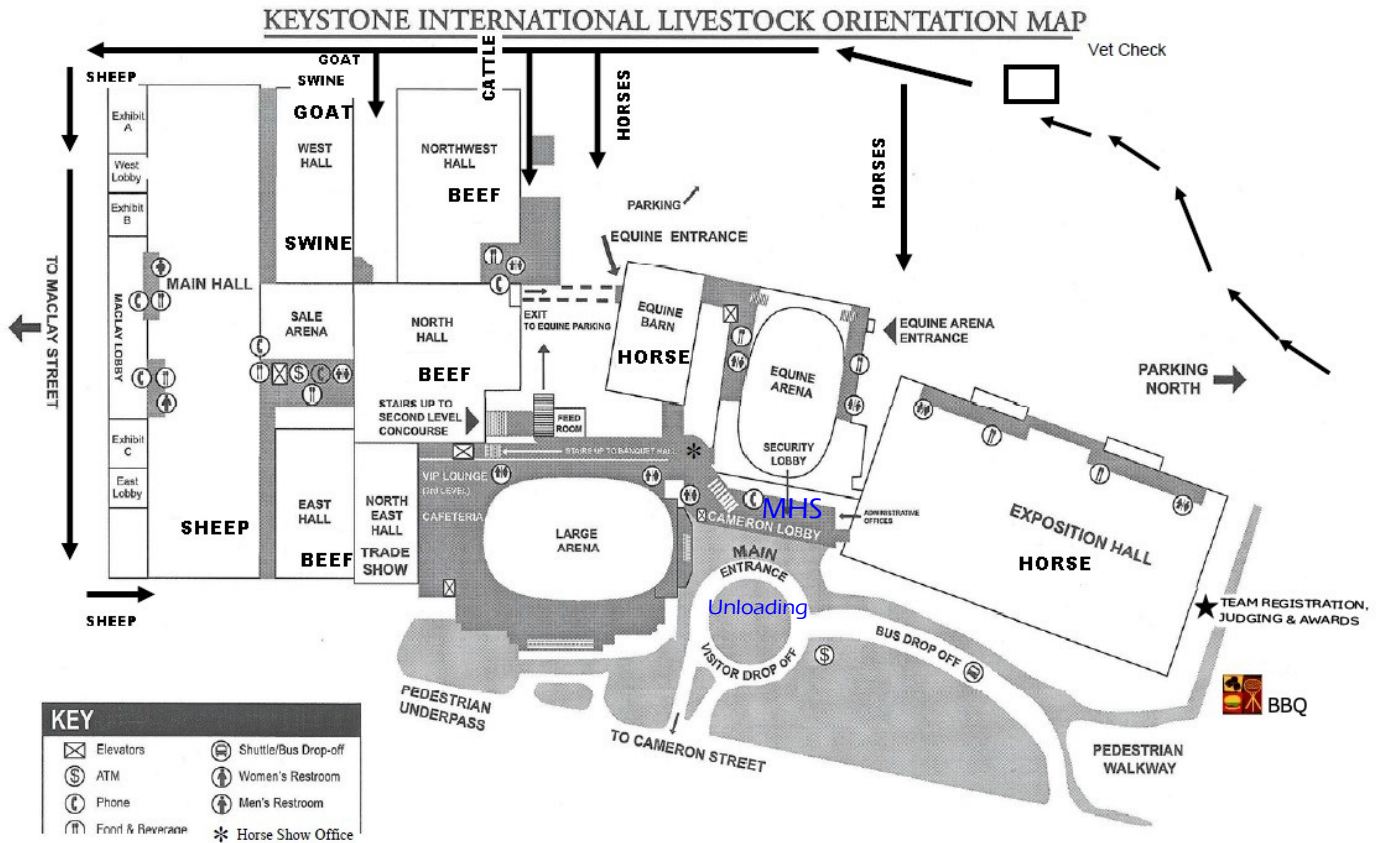
BREED:

- If you're still confused, feel free to ask the judge where he or she would like to see a particular model. We do ask, however, that you limit such inquiries so the judges are not bombarded with these questions at the show.

JUDGES/JUDGING: The full roster of judges will be posted on the website and on Facebook (KILE Open Horse Show) as soon as details are finalized.

SILENT AUCTION

LOADING/UNLOADING: Loading and unloading can be done via the Cameron Street Circle. Parking is available in the North Lot (main lot). Security will be on hand to help direct you.



Rules

1. Models must be Original Finish, and Plastic, Resin or China.
 2. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per class.
 3. Classes are not restricted by brand of model. In other words, Breyer models to show with Stone models.
- APPLICATION FOR ENTRY
4. Entries must be postmarked or computer time stamped (online registration) on or before Sept. 16, 2016. Early entries are encouraged. For entries submitted after 9/16/2015, a late fee of \$ 10.00 per exhibitor will be assessed for each entry.
 5. All applications for entry must be made on forms provided by the EXPOSITION (additional entry forms may be requested or photo copied. A separate entry form must be used for each exhibitor. Exhibits may also be entered through the online registration program, or download additional forms from www.keystoneinternational.state.pa.us. In all cases, the right is reserved to reject entirely or accept conditionally any entry or application.
 6. Entry fees are non-refundable.
 7. IDENTIFICATION TAGS: ALL horses must have attached toe tag identifying them; this is how show results will be recorded.
 - Breed and gender are displayed on the front (and age for foals please).
 - Horse name (that you picked, not the model name) and your chosen initials on the back.
 - When the horse is placed in the ring, the front (breed/gender side) of the tag MUST be facing up.
 - Any horse with an improperly displayed or missing tag will not be judged, so please double check before you leave the ring!
 8. To keep the show timely, there will be 3 minutes between halter classes and 5 minutes between performance classes. Please plan accordingly and be alert for announcements of the classes.
 9. Once a class is closed, no more horses may be added to the ring.
 10. Only ONE halter class per model is permitted.
 11. Performance entries will be judged on how accurately they represent the event being shown. Entries should be correct, realistic, and presented with attention to detail. Please do your research so that your entry is correct with reference to tack, props, the horse's position and gait, etc.
 12. Judges' decisions are final. If you have questions about a particular class, please do not interrupt the judges while they are busy judging. Ask a committee member to connect you with the judge when there is a break in the schedule. Arguing with judges is not permitted.
 13. Halter/headgear permitted in the halter classes as long as it appropriate to the breed/type. No dolls/props are to be used in halter classes.
 14. Open classes are open to any exhibitor that owns the model.
 15. Novice is defined as someone who has not won a champion or reserve at a novice or open level.
 16. Youth is defined as an exhibitor 12 years of age and under.
 17. Classes may be split at the judge's or show manager's discretion and may not be split based solely on the number of entries. The two horse limit would still apply; you can only enter two horses total between the two new classes.
 18. If a horse has a tendency to tip over, you may show it lying down. Only then can you use a piece of felt/towel/cloth for the horse to lie on (no bigger than 8 1/2 x 11 inches). Please note that by lying a horse down in the show ring, you are giving the judge permission to pick the horse up for inspection and to judge both sides.
 19. Yearlings and Weanlings are considered Foals.
 20. Explanations, photos, diagrams, and patterns should be no more than 8 1/2" x 11" total per entry.
 21. Miniature Horse types can show with Pony.
 22. "Longears" refers to donkeys and mules.
 23. Dressage entries must have a proper dressage test and show where the horse is in that test.
 24. Please quiet cell phones and keep noise to a minimum so other exhibitors can hear the announcements.
 25. No running, smoking or pets in the show hall.
 26. Entrants are permitted to sell items from their show tables. However, please keep aisles open.
 27. Please do not handle other exhibits without the exhibitor's permission.
 28. The management reserves to its officers and Executive Committee the final and absolute right to interpret these rules, regulations and classifications, and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions or differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, or connected with, or incident to, the EXPOSITION.
