The objectives of this class are to present a class of ewe lambs and yearlings in a most attractive manner and give spectators an opportunity to see the best of the sheep industry.

Competition is open to anyone between the ages of 9 and 21, as of October 1, 2011. The entrant will be judged on the mode of dress selected which must be appropriate, attractive, and lend dignity to the class. Entrant must furnish own outfit, made of at least 80 percent wool.

There will be three divisions: Junior, Intermediate, and Senior. Contestants will be assigned to each of the divisions by age in approximately equal numbers after entries close. The decision of the Chairperson is final.

Sheep used must be *REGISTERED YEARLING EWES OR EWE LAMBS* that have been conditioned, fitted and trained to show at halter. All animals must meet the health rules as printed on page 118.

Application forms are available only from the chairperson, Annette Lovell. Entry fee is \$6.00. All entries must be postmarked by September 15 and **sent separately from other KILE fees to the chairperson, Annette Lovell.**

Entries will be judged according to the following score card:

40 - Contestant and Contestant's Outfit
25 - Control & Presentation
35 - Appearance of Ewe
100

1st-\$40; 2nd-\$30; 3rd-\$20; 4th thru 8th-\$10 each; 9th and 10th-\$5 each. Special Awards will also be awarded by breed associations and various other donors.
